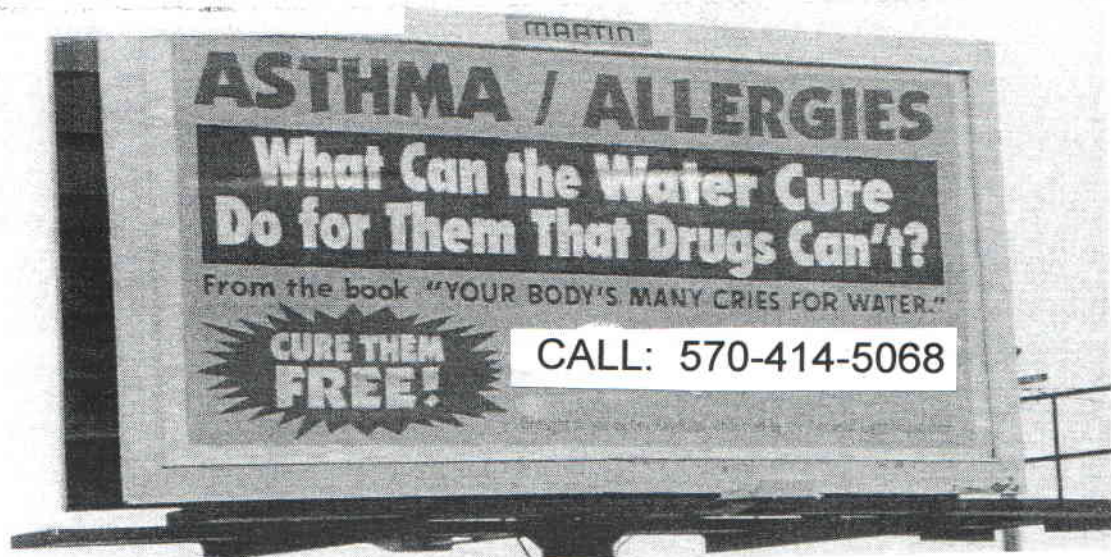


IT IS INHUMAN TO ALLOW ONE CHILD TO SUFFER FROM ASTHMA

Hope through the 'water cure' withheld from asthma support group

I recently attended the first Asthma Support Group sponsored by a Pennsylvania rehabilitation center on Jan. 27.

I was there with Bob Butts, promoter of the "water cure," and an asthmatic named Sandy.

Tony, one of the therapists, told us how the "water cure" by Dr. F. Batmanghelidj helped his asthma and recommended it to everyone there.

Everyone said they had heard the radio spots and saw the newspaper ads on the "water cure." But I was sad to see one of the facilitators cut Tony's talk short.

Bob was then given permission to speak, but was immediately stopped and rudely told that this was not the place and time to discuss the "water cure," but that they would consider having Bob as a future speaker. That

was a joke because Bob was later told not to give out any information on the "water cure" on the premises.

I thought to myself, "This is a support group?"

I guess when you are selling rehab to asthmatics, the last thing anyone wants to hear is something that will make their jobs unnecessary.

Then it was Sandy's turn to talk. She mentioned how the "water cure" reduced her asthma, cutting it by 90 percent. But she was cut short also.

Then it was my turn. I said I never had asthma, but did suffer from bronchitis and severe allergies which according to Dr. Batmanghelidj go hand-in-hand. I have been cured of all my allergies and bronchitis. They didn't want to hear that. And once again we were told, "You don't belong here."

They were right. We didn't belong

there because we don't support asthma, we support its cure: the "water cure."

All wrong is done out of ignorance. I truly believe after attending this support group that its sponsors are ignorant.

Is it also possible that they are only interested in keeping people sick for profit? It appears that there is a ton of money being made on rehab, and the "water cure" is a big threat to this profit bonanza.

But we'll win because we work from the heart, not from the wallet.

I was not only angered by the attitude of this center, but also felt deeply sorry for all asthmatics out there who will suffer, or possibly die, if they are not told about the "water cure."
